NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Village Board of the Village of Rochester, Racine County, Wisconsin, of a public hearing on Ordinance No. 2022-3:

“Ordinance #2022-3 "An Ordinance to Repeal and Re-Create Section 30-14 A.2. of the Village Code Concerning Wetland Setbacks and Private Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems””

to be held on Monday, June 6, 2022 at 7:30 p.m. in the Rochester Village Hall, 300 West Spring Street, Rochester, Wisconsin.

The proposed amendment notes an exception to Section 30-14 of the land division code to allow for the installation of private onsite wastewater treatment systems within a defined 75-foot wetland buffer area that is otherwise restricted from development.
